SHOW POINTS

The Show points system is very simple and runs from Jan 1st - Dec 31st

For every class you receive points according to your place, see the table below.

Any points gained as a puppy under 12 months of age do not count towards the award for Top Dog.

It is the owner's responsibility to submit their results to the CEDCGB.

WORKING POINTS

The working points system starts from the first rally entered by any musher through to the last rally entered in the season. The season is usually Oct - Mar. It is biased in favour of teams in which all the dogs are CED's. Mixed teams, no matter what ratio will only be awarded ½ points. However there is a 2 point bonus for any team finishing 1st - 3rd overall in their class.

A separate 'Certificate of Merit' for best Multi-sports dog will also be awarded for those CED's taking part in Bike-jor/Scooter/Canicross/skijor classes.

Weight Pull and Back Packing events have their own separate titles and awards and results aren't eligible towards the working title.
